

## Guidelines for Earth Day Trash Pick-up Contest

April 17, 2010

All group leaders who have pre-registered must be on the Mall at 7:45 a.m. to pick up their Earth Day packets. If you have not pre-registered, please wait until all registered group leaders have been given their packets. We will have 3 lines open and your packets will be filed alphabetically by the group leader's last name. The Earth Day packets will include a map showing your assigned area and route number, gloves, garbage bags, and markers. **All bags must be marked with your assigned route number on each garbage bag.** Please make sure all bags are full. All full bags will be counted and tallied according to the route number written on the bags by the group leaders. No garbage bags other than the official bags will be allowed for this contest. All bags must be completely full and tied. Bags turned in that are not completely full will be combined with other such bags to count as one.

For those children who are under the age of 18, adult supervision is required. We will have police in the area, but parents are needed to guide and keep minor children safe.

Drinks will be available to carry with you or brought to you during the pickup time. When you return to the Mall, please go to the area marked **T-Shirts**. Someone will be there to verify that everyone on your list was present. Then go to the area marked **Lunch** and pick up a bagged lunch. Hopefully, by the time your group has eaten, your t-shirts will be ready for pickup by the group leader.

All groups must return to the Mall Pavilion between 11:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. The contest will officially close at 11:30 a.m. and the civic organization winners will be posted on the Trussville Utilities Website at [www.trussville.com](http://www.trussville.com) by noon on Monday, April 19, 2010.

### Guidelines for Trash Pickup

Remove litter along the ten-foot right-of-way on both sides of the road in your designated area. Avoid contact with items that have the potential to be hazardous or cause injury, such as heavy objects or items like syringes, needles, used condoms, animal bodies, etc.
